Some HCOs have to be contacted individually (as deiscribed in the consent description provided by Pharmig).</li> <li>If the HCOs are not included in the list provided by Pharmig, then an individual consent is collected from this HCO. If the consent is withdrawn, then the HCO is disclosed aggregated and the recipient's identity is therefore not publically available.</li> </ul>
